

# Shaping Skills Checklist

## Planning. The teacher:

- Identifies the actions that make up the final behavior.
- Selects objects to use that will encourage the desired actions.
- Writes a list of shaping steps.

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## Reinforcement system. The teacher:

- Keeps his or her hand in a base position between block deliveries.
- Clicks immediately when the desired behavior occurs.
- Does not click for undesired behaviors.
- Clicks and THEN moves his or her hand to reach for a block.
- Gives the block to the hand the learner uses to touch the objects.

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## Shaping skills. The teacher:

- Provides reinforcement for one criterion at a time.
- Moves to the next step after two to four correct repetitions of the current step.
- Goes back a step, changes something, or takes a break if the learner does three undesired behaviors in a row or if more than 10 seconds elapse without a click.
- Uses a logical object to teach each action. Then, if needed, transfers the action.
- When necessary, resets the object or objects after the click.
- Does not talk or make facial expressions while teaching.
- Looks at the objects and the learner's hands, not at the learner's face.
- Takes a break after 10 reinforcers to fill out the data sheet and evaluate progress.
